## MGA NEWS By: Mike Cox

"Quota! Quota! Quota!" I can still remember the chants of glee during the Team Quota Tournament scene from my favorite movie "Animal House". (Or was that Toga! Toga! Toga!) It doesn't matter, when a tournament is as much fun as a toga party you gotta get a team together and sign up.

There's plenty of time to get your buddies together to form a team. Quota! Quota! Quota! Is being held Saturday, Feb. 21. 1 PM Shotgun includes Lunch served prior to Tee Off.

What's so fun about this tournament? First, you get to form your own team of golf buddies. If you don't have time to put a team together, no worries mate, like an attorney, one can be assigned to you. The Pro shop will keep a list of individual players to put teams together. So just sign up.

Second, you're not playing for a low stroke score. You're playing for points! 5 points for an eagle, 3 for a birdie, 2 for par, 1 for bogey, 0 for double bogey and -1 for anything worse. So you see, slamming 3 balls into the lake prior to bouncing one off a tree out of bounds won't hurt much. You only lose 1 point. Nail a birdie on the next hole to make 4 points and you whole team will be gleefully chanting "Quota! Quota! Quota!"

So, what is your quota to make? Don't ask. It's better if you don't know. But if you must know, here goes: the team quota is the sum total of each individual player's quota. A player's quota is the number of points that the player should score in a round. Each player's quota is computed (does that word even belong in golf?) by subtracting the player's handicap from 36. Each player then scores points using a modified Stableford System (described above). The player's score for the round is computed (there's that word again!) by subtracting his score from his quota. Aren't you glad you asked? Don't worry if this doesn't make sense, just make points. Remember to sign up by end of day Thursday, Feb. 19.

Cost is a cool \$30.00 per player which includes Lunch prior to the round.

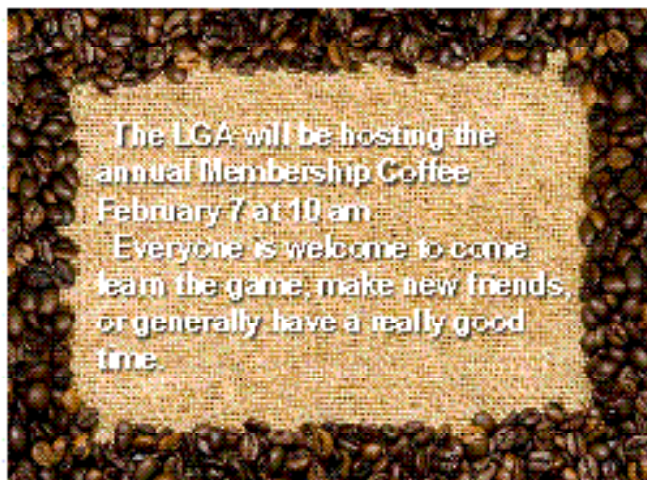

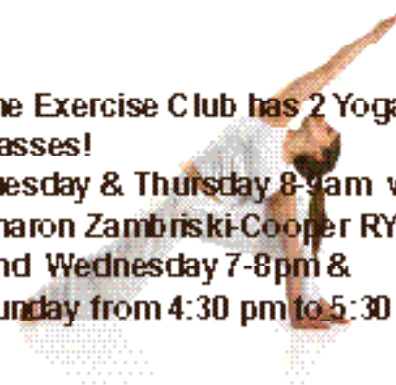
